

# WWN Trees in Easement Guideline

The Town Of Fishers recommends a planting distance for easement trees (trees between the sidewalk and the street) at 35 to 40 feet on center.

The Town Of Fishers recommends trees that will grow fairly tall (maximum height of 50 feet), so they can be maintained with high limbs. This allows the trees to be trimmed up which then avoids problems with the limbs being low in the street which cause problems for mail trucks and other vehicles, as well as pedestrians on the sidewalk. Tall trees also allow better visibility for vehicle traffic and pedestrian traffic.
